

Pastor's Message



Dear Church Family:

It has been and IS a hot summer! The weather reports indicate it might be cooling down some in the next few days. Unfortunately, in addition to the hot weather there are a number of fires burning in San Bernardino, Riverside and Orange Counties. This represents a great loss of personal property for many families. As I am writing this newsletter—some of the fires are not yet contained and the firefighters are working under severe weather conditions as well as a very steep terrain in some areas. We need to remember these fireman and their families in our prayers. They are faithfully carrying out their responsibilities to protect our communities and often risking their own lives to injury and harm.

The smoke and ashes permeate the air. As you know Karen and I live in Banning and we

have had ashes from the fires landing in our yard and on our patio. It is amazing how far the smoke and ashes travel before landing! Some people have lost their home, car and all their personal belongings—total devastation! It happened so quickly and the fires continue through the nights! Fortunately, temporary shelter is being provided for some of the families and some of their animals. It is difficult to imagine what some of these families are going through and the challenging future they face.

Locally, we are concerned about the heat and the fires. Nationally, people are concerned about the upcoming election and the important choices that need to be made in this election cycle. The recent debates may have helped a few people with their decision making process but the interviews indicate that few people changed their minds about who they were voting for. I believe it is imperative that each of us lift up all of our leaders in prayer. I noticed the date of this letter is 9-11! I am sure we all can recall what we were doing and where we were on the day of that tragedy. Pray for our leaders!
